

Bay Village High School RELEASE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION

Optional opt out of directory information, otherwise legally designated a public record. Includes specific exclusion of information to armed forces recruiters.

1. Directory Information Notice

Students and their parents or guardians may object to the release of student Directory Information (which we are otherwise required to release upon request by law). Directory Information includes: name, address, telephone number, field of study, activity and sports participation, athletic height and weight, attendance, graduation date and awards. A written objection must be given to the principal to opt out of student's release of directory information.

Please check and sign if you object to the release of student Directory Information: Student information will not be included in public documents such as yearbooks, performance programs, requests from colleges/universities for mailing lists, nonprofit groups, etc. □ **DO NOT** include my student, _____ in any request for Directory Information. (Student name & grade level.) (Parent Signature) (Date) 2. Specific exclusion for release of directory information to armed forces recruiters ONLY. Directory information requested by armed forces recruiters must be released under the No Child Left Behind law. Parents/guardians or students 18 years of age may specifically exclude having the student's directory information distributed to armed forces recruiters by making such a request in writing to the high school office. ☐ **DO NOT** include my student, in any request for Directory Information by the armed forces. (Student name & grade level.) (Parent Signature)

State law specifies that directory information cannot be released for profit-making purposes.
